## HOW WE HELP

### FINANCIAL AID

Your support enables us to help pay for:

- Rent or mortgage
- Utility bills (water, gas, electric)
- Phone
- Car payment or car insurance

To qualify, patients must be:

- Age 18 or older
- Current Florida resident
- Actively undergoing cancer treatment or within 90 days of final treatment. Eligible treatment is chemotherapy, radiation, immunotherapy, hormone therapy, and stem cell transplants.
- Receiving treatment from a Florida oncologist
- Have annual household income at or below 200% of national poverty guidelines
- Have less than \$5,000 in liquid assets
