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How to Apply for Financial Aid

All applications must be submitted online at FCSF.org/financial-aid

- If you do not have access to a computer, please call the Foundation to have a volunteer or staff member help you complete an application over the phone. You may bring required documents to your oncologist's office for them to assist you in faxing documents to **813-623-4703** or emailing them to foundation@flcancer.com

To qualify, patients must

- Be age 18 or older and a current Florida resident
- Be actively undergoing cancer treatment or within 90 days of final treatment. Eligible treatment includes chemotherapy, radiation, immunotherapy, hormone therapy, and hematopoietic progenitor cell transplantation.
- Have annual household income at or below 200% of national poverty guidelines
- Be treated by a Florida oncologist
- Have less than \$5,000 in liquid assets



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
